Savanna Restoration

- Introduce scattered native trees
- Convert fallow field thru proper controlled burn management to eliminate invasive species
- Seed w/ native grass & wildflower species
- Conduct selective clearing at woodland edge
- Develop interpretive trails



Woodland Enhancement

- Conduct selective clearing
- Reduce competition for specimen trees
- Reduce invasive species
- Promote healthy diversity in all plant communities



Prairie Restoration

- Convert cool-season grasses to deep-rooted prairie for improved wildlife habitat
- Conduct selective tree clearing
- Install diverse native grasses & wildflowers
- Create wildlife habitat structure
