Lemont Township is now coordinating efforts to best serve the seniors and those with disabilities in our community during the COVID19 outbreak. We are partnering with CNNSSA who provides "Meals on Wheels" to the seniors in our community, as well as lunches for our Lemont Café senior nutrition site. We are working to provide frozen lunches to the seniors who are active participants now, as well as to those living in the two senior communities of Graceview Senior Apartments and St. Francis of Assisi Residence. We will also assist seniors (60+), or those with disabilities we know of, or are made aware of, who are in need. *Please spread the word to have them reach out to Lemont Township Human Services to see how to best address their needs.*

In addition, Lemont Township is now a "Hub" for donations of basic needs products, as well as other items that seniors/disabled may need but cannot gain access to. We are working on coordinating drop offs of these donations via the Township vehicles, so as to limit the seniors exposure.
