

The Cook County Department of Revenue

With residents continuing to face many challenges and difficulties created by the coronavirus, Cook County Board President Toni Preckwinkle and the Department of Revenue (DOR) are working to provide meaningful relief throughout Cook County. We have made changes to the upcoming Wheel Tax 2021/2022 License year that will help reduce fines and extend deadlines for payment because it is the right thing to do during these trying times.

- We are extending the current Wheel Tax license year by two months to August 31, 2021, providing extra time and flexibility to vehicle owners. The New License Period will extend from September 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.
- Vehicle owners will continue to have a 30-day grace period after the due date where the late fee will be reduced to \$25; after the 30-day grace period expires the late fee will return to 100% of the tax due.
- Remit payment by utilizing the Wheel Tax Liability Notification that you will be receiving the coming weeks.
- Payments accepted online, by mail, in-person at DOR and 100+ participating ELS locations.
